A Year of Powerful Cognacs

A vintage cognac is quite simply defined. It consist of cognacs from single year's growth. In the case of HINE's Vintages, the cognac is taken only from the Grande Champagne region. At the heart of the finest vineyards. They are aged in our 18th century cellars in Jarnac under a two lock and key system - one belonging to HINE and the other to the cognac authorities.

For any given vintage, the annual climate and the storage conditions influence the taste and the ageing process of the cognac, making each vintage unique.

This very powerful 1975 Grande Champagne is dominated by tannins and spices. On the palate the volume and persistence confirm the first impressions on the nose. A very masculine cognac.
